Jupiter in Sagittarius

2018 is a special year for Jupiter, because in November this planet (affectionately known as the “prince” of the planets) enters one of the signs he rules: Sagittarius! Sagittarius represents Jupiter’s expansive and exploratory qualities, and is one of the speedier signs of the zodiac. The arrow is the symbol of Sagittarius, and that represents the hurried and purposeful nature of activities done in this sign.

Sagittarius is a Fire sign, which means it has associations with passion, excitement, and strong action. It is also a Mutable sign, which signifies quick and responsive action– the ability to adapt to change course like lightning.

Every sign can be split into three “decans” of equal size. Each one is ten degrees, and is said to be ruled by a different planet. That decan can be considered a different “flavor” of the sign, bringing out a different side or phase in its cycle.

Mercury rules the first Decan of the sign. Usually the quickest planet, Mercury feels behind here, and scattered! Sagittarius isn’t about a carefully formulated plan, it’s about getting from point A to point B quickly! Mercury wants to look at the *best* path, and any time it takes to think things through creates more of a sense of being behind. This part of Sagittarius can feel rushed, frantic, and scattered, as a result.

The Moon rules the second Decan of the sign. The Moon is actually the quickest of the planets in astrological tradition, and thus can keep up with the quick pace of Sagittarius. Not only can it keep up, it revels in the speed! The Moon is the center of our emotional selves, and enjoying the purpose and passion of this sign is what this Decan is all about. The path is set, the speed is building momentum, and it looks like nothing can stop us from achieving our goals!

Saturn rules the third Decan of the sign. As it turns out, the pace of Sagittarius is ultimately unsustainable, and Saturn reminds us that all good things must come to an end. Hopefully if we did take a few seconds to make sure we had enough fuel for our journey, when we get to the end we can actually make it to our destination! If not, we may have fizzled like a dud firework!



Sagittarius for You

Our exact time of birth tells us our Rising Sign, or the sign of the zodiac that was on the eastern horizon at the moment of our birth. The Rising Sign is important because it lays out the topics that each sign of the zodiac plays throughout our lives. These topics are called "Houses", and there are different ways to divide the zodiac into these 12 houses. The ancient Hellenistic astrologers used a system called Whole Sign House division, in which you simply assign a house topic to each sign of the zodiac.

The way we assign houses begins with your Rising Sign as the First House. Then, going in zodiacal order (counter-clockwise on a chart), we assign each consecutive sign the next house. So, for example, if your Rising Sign is Pisces, your First House is Pisces, your Second House is Aries, your Third House is Taurus, and so on until you assign the Twelfth House to Aquarius.

Learning from the Past

Unless you're 11 years old, Jupiter has been in Sagittarius sometime before during your lifetime, and for many of us it's been there multiple times! While reflecting on our past can be difficult due to the nature of how we experience time and memory, it can be very valuable in terms of understanding Jupiter's impact on us while in Sagittarius.

When Jupiter transits a sign, it usually has three phases: direct motion for 4 months, retrograde motion for 4 months, then direct motion for the last 4-5 months as it covers the rest of the sign. For Sagittarius, these phases take on the following meaning:

- Finding the Right Vessel: You are locating exactly what resources or vehicle will help you get to your goal or destination. Sometimes this can take a while, or sometimes you have a sudden burst of inspiration and you find what you're looking for early on! Multiple test drives are okay– the important thing is making sure you've got what you're looking for.
- Strapping In: It's time to take off, and make sure your seatbelt is securely fastened! This phase can bring ups and downs, delays and detours, but once you're going, there's no turning back. You've made the commitment and giving up now would mean abandoning the entire project you've put resources into.
- Hoping you have enough Fuel: This last phase really puts you and your "vessel" to the test. Did you fill up your tank with enough resources when you started this journey? If not, you might not end up making it to where you wanted to get to. This is where Jupiter's tendency to over-do things might have caused you to bite off more than you can chew. But– not all is lost if you don't find your destination! You may have gotten close, or even close enough if you take a step back. Either way, learning from what happened is the best way to salvage something meaningful from the experience.

In the next section, you'll see these three phases covering different historical periods, as well as the current transit of Jupiter through Sagittarius. Use the reflection prompts to help you identify what themes were playing out in your own life related to these cycles. There is also some information about what was happening at the time, historically.

Memory is not perfect! Hindsight may be 20/20, but some of these prompts or patterns might be asking you to consider a time in your life from a completely different or new perspective. Feel free to bounce around between phases, between transits, or come back after processing subconsciously. In this way, astrology helps us look back at our own histories and find new meaning or importance for healing our present and setting us up for a brighter future.

November 2006 – December 2007

Phase 1: "Finding the right vessel" (starts November 23, 2006)

- Jan 9, 2007 – Jupiter enters the shadow of its future retrograde (foreshadowing what the next phase will be about)

Historical Events:

- Dec 10 – Space Shuttle *Discovery* launches for the first time since 2003's loss of *Columbia*
- Jan 9 – Steve Jobs announces the first iPhone developed by Apple
- Feb 2 – IPCC concludes global climate change is likely to have predominantly human causes
- Feb 10 – Barack Obama declares his candidacy for President of the United States
- Feb 28 – The *New Horizons* space probe uses Jupiter's gravity to slingshot toward Pluto
- Apr 3 – French high speed passenger train breaks fastest record for speed

- Aug 4 – The *Phoenix* spacecraft is launched to study Mars

- Aug 30 – 6 Nuclear Warheads were mistakenly flown from North Dakota to Louisiana
- Nov 14 – High Speed 1 from London to the Channel Tunnel opens
- Sep 25 – Halo 3 is released, breaking multiple records and generating \$170 million in 24 hours
- Oct 9 – Dow Jones hits relative high of 14,164 before the late 2000's recession
- Nov 5 – Writer's Guild of America goes on strike

- Jan 4, 1995 – Jupiter enters the shadow of its future retrograde (foreshadowing what the next phase will be about)

Historical Events:

- Dec 14 – A small plane crashed into an apartment complex in Fresno, California and a runaway freight train collided with another in Cajon Pass, California
- Jan 25 – Norwegian rocket is mistaken for a Russian missile launch
- Jan 31 – President Clinton approves a \$20 billion loan to Mexico to avoid financial collapse
- Feb 21 – First solo flight across the Pacific Ocean in a hot-air balloon
- Mar 14 – First American to ride into space aboard a Russian launch vehicle
- Mar 31 – A flight from Bucharest to Brussels crashes shortly after takeoff

- Sep 1 – Airplane is shot down by Soviet forces, killing 269 people including a US Congressman
- Sep 16 – Global Positioning Satellites (GPS) made available for public use
- Oct 4 – Richard Noble sets the world's land speed record driving "Thrust2"

Current Jupiter Transit through Sagittarius

Now that you're familiar with the Jupiter phase and its historical transits through Sagittarius, it's time to focus on its present journey through the sign of the archer!

Use the next four pages as a road map through the three phases. You'll find room to take notes throughout the phase, and journal prompts to use at the end of each phase in order to better reflect on the current events in your life or in the world.

Often it can be hard to understand what's happening astrologically when you're in the middle of it, but reflecting back on things after a few weeks or months can really put things in the right perspective! Revisit this frequently in order to gain the best insights into how you're experiencing Jupiter's transit.

Other Astrological Techniques

If you focus on other Jupiter-related transits (such as Natal Transits, or aspects to your Natal Chart at birth), you can find even more insight into these historical or present transits through Sagittarius. Learning these astrological techniques can bring even more depth to your journaling and reflection.

For example, in your natal chart, if you are a Virgo rising and Jupiter is in your first house of Virgo, its transit through Sagittarius will impact your 4th House of Home, Family, and Parents, but it will also make between 1 and 3 aspects (depending on your exact degree) to your Natal Jupiter. These dates will become important and will also impact your 1st House of Self, Mind, Body, and New Beginnings.

In addition to the occasional reflection prompts in the last section, this section contains a calendar of every time Jupiter aligns with any of the planets, including the Moon. Each month contains a summary of the major and minor aspects involved, as well as additional reflection questions for you to consider that month.

The best way to use this journal is to revisit it a few times a month— you could even make a habit out of doing it every Saturday afternoon, for example. Each time you revisit it, you'll make connections to new events, and in-between your mind will subconsciously process the information. Don't worry if you're staring at a blank page, in other words— review the calendar and come back a few days later. You'll be surprised how much you can connect after a little bit of background processing!
